National Federation of Information Commissions in India (NFICI)

The National Federation of Information Commissions in India (NFICI) was specially formed as a registered body on 01.09.2009 to facilitate co-ordination and mutual consultation among the Central Information Commission and the State Information Commissions constituted under the Right to Information Act, 2005. All the participating Information Commissions have paid Rs. 5.00 lakh towards Admission Fee initially and in addition an Annual Membership fee of Rs. 1.00 lakh is also being contributed. Tamil Nadu Information Commissions became a member of the National Federation of Information Commissions in India in 2011. The Federation is managed by a Board of Governors which is chaired by the Chief Information Commissioner, Central Information Commission and Chief Information Commissioners of State Commissions are elected to represent the various zones in the Board.

2. The State Chief Information Commissioner, Tamil Nadu Information Commission has been elected to the Board of Governors to represent the Southern Zone w.e.f 03.09.2021.
