The Right to Information Act, 2005, (Central Act 22 of 2005) is one of the significant legislation, which was enacted by the Parliament and notified in the official Gazette on 21st of June, 2005, and came into force on 12th October, 2005. The provisions of sub-section (1) of section 4, sub-sections (1) and (2) of section 5, Sections 12, 13, 15, 16, 24, 27 and 28 came into force with effect from the date of notification and the remaining provisions of the Act came into force on 12th October, 2005. The main objectives of the Right to Information Act are Transparency, Accountability and elimination of corruption in the Governmental machinery.

CHAPTER – 3

3.1. State Information Commission

As provided under Section 15 (1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005, the Government of Tamil Nadu constituted the Tamil Nadu Information Commission vide G.O. (Ms). No 988, Public (Estt I & Leg.) Department, dated 07.10.2005. This Act prescribes the powers and functions of the Commission under Sections 18, 19 and 20 in dealing with complaint, appeal and penalties respectively.

3.2.Appointment of State Chief Information Commissioner and State Information Commissioners

Under Section 15(3) of the Right to Information Act, 2005, Thiru Md.Shakeel Akhter, I.P.S(Retd), was appointed as the State Chief Information Commissioner on 16.06.2023.



CHAPTER - 4

4.1. Rules Notified under the Right to Information Act, 2005

As per Section 27(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005, the appropriate Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, make rules to carry out the provisions of this Act. Similarly, as per Section 28(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005, the competent authority may, by notification in the Official Gazette, make rules to carry out the provisions of this Act.

4.2. Fees to be paid under the Tamil Nadu Right to Information (Fees) Rules, 2005

The Government of Tamil Nadu vide G.O.Ms.No.989, Public (Estt.I & Leg.) Department, dated 07.10.2005, has notified the Tamil Nadu Right to Information (Fees) Rules, 2005. Subsequently, certain amendments were issued to the said rules vide G.O.Ms.No.1012, Public (Estt.I & Leg.) Department, dated 20.09.2006, G.O.Ms.No.72, Personnel and Administrative Reforms (AR III) Department, dated 20.03.2007 and G.O.Ms.No.12, Personnel and Administrative Reforms (AR III) Department dated 18.01.2011. CHAPTER – 5

5.1.The Tamil Nadu Information Commission (Appeal Procedure) Rules, 2012

In G.O.Ms.No.137, Personnel and Administrative Reforms (AR-III) Department, dated 03.09.2012, the Tamil Nadu Information Commission (Appeal Procedure) Rules, 2012, were notified. These Rules lay down the procedure to be followed for filing of second appeals by the Appellants in the Tamil Nadu Information Commission and also the procedure for deciding the appeals. The important provisions of the Tamil Nadu Information Commission (Appeal Procedure) Rules, 2012 are as follows:

➤ **Contents of appeal:-**

(1) An appeal to the Commission shall contain the following particulars, namely:-

- i. Name and address of the appellant;
- ii. Name and address of the Public Information Officer against the decision of whom the appeal is preferred;
- iii. Name and address of the Appellate Authority against the decision of whom the appeal is preferred;
- iv. Information sought in the petition under the Act;
- v. Particulars of the order including number, if any, against which the appeal is preferred;
- vi. Brief facts leading to the appeal;
- vii. Prayer and grounds for such prayer;
- viii. If the appeal is preferred against deemed refusal, the particulars of the application, including number and date and name and address of the Public Information Officer / Appellate Authority to whom the application was made;
- ix. Verification by the appellant; and
- x. Any other Information which the commission may deem necessary for deciding the appeal;

- (2) The appeals shall be addressed only to the Tamil Nadu Information Commission and shall not be addressed to the names of the Chief Information Commissioner or the Information Commissioners.

➤ **Documents to accompany appeal-**

Every appeal made to the Commission shall be accompanied by the following documents, namely:-

- (i) Self-attested copies of the orders or documents against which the appeal is being preferred.
- (ii) Copies of documents relied upon by the appellant and referred to in the appeal;
- (iii) Copy of petition given to the Public Information Officer;
- (iv) Copy of appeal given to the Appellate Authority;
- (v) Copy of reply or information furnished by the Public Information Officer;
- (vi) Copy of reply or information furnished by the Appellate Authority;
- (vii) In case of alleged incomplete or incorrect information, the details thereof;
- (viii) An index of the documents referred to in the appeal.

➤ **Procedure in deciding appeal-**

(1) In deciding the appeal, the Commission may-

- (i) hear oral or written evidence on affidavit from concerned or interested person;
- (ii) peruse or inspect documents, public records or copies thereof;
- (iii) inquire through authorized officer further details or facts;
- (iv) hear Public Information Officer, Assistant Public Information Officer or such Senior Officer who decide the first appeal, or such person against whom the complaint is made, as the case may be;
- (v) hear third party;
- (vi) receive evidence on affidavits from Public Information Officer, Assistant Public Information Officer, such senior officer who decided the first appeal, such person against whom the complaint lies or the third party;
- (vii) issue orders or directions based on available documents or evidences without personal enquiry, if the Commission is satisfied about the adequacy of such material;
- (viii) initiate an inquiry if it is satisfied that there are reasonable grounds to inquire into the matter and issue orders;

- (ix) conduct inquiry in the Head Quarters of the Commission or in the offices established at other places in the State with the previous approval of the State Government;
 - (x) conduct inquiry through video conference also.
- (2) In case the Commission decides to impose penalty, reasonable opportunity shall be given to Public Information Officer and Other Officers, including the time sought by them to defend their case in another date.

➤ **Service of Notice by Commission-**

Notice to be issued by the Commission may be served in any of the following modes, namely-

- (i) service by the party itself;
- (ii) by hand delivery through Process Server;
- (iii) by registered post with acknowledgement due; or
- (iv) through Head of Office or Department

➤ **Personal presence of the appellant or complainant-**

- (1) The appellant or the complainant, as the case may be, shall in every case be informed of the date of hearing at least seven clear days before that date.
- (2) The appellant or the complainant, as the case may be, shall be present in person at the time of hearing of the appeal or complaint by the Commission.
- (3) Where the circumstances exist due to which the appellant or the complainant, as the case may be, is being prevented from attending the hearing of the Commission, then, the Commission may afford the appellant or the complainant, as the case may be, another opportunity of being heard before a final decision is taken or take any other appropriate action as it may deem fit; Provided the appellant or the complainant, as the case may be, should inform the Commission the reasons for not attending the hearing in writing or through any other mode of communication in advance before the hearing is taken up.
- (4) The appellant or the complainant, as the case may be, may seek the assistance of any person in the process of the appeal while presenting his points and the person representing him may not be a legal practitioner.

➤ **Personal presence of the Public Information Officer-**

- (1) The Public Information Officer or Assistant Public Information Officer or such Senior Officer who decided the first appeal, such person against whom the complaint lies, shall in every case, be informed of the date of hearing at least seven days before that date.
- (2) The Public Information Officer or Assistant Public Information Officer of such senior officer, who is summoned by the Commission, shall invariably be present in person. The Commission may at its discretion permit an authorized representative, but such a representative shall be an officer of sufficient seniority.
- (3) Where the Commission is satisfied that there are compelling circumstances such as, attending flood relief works, epidemic control measures and containing of law and order problem for the Public Information Officer or Assistant Public Information Officer or such officer or the other officials summoned for not attending the hearing of the Commission, the Commission may give another opportunity of being heard. The reason shall invariably be intimated to the Commission in advance, by the officials. Routine excuses shall not be entertained by the Commission.

➤ **Order of the Commission-**

Order of the Commission shall be in writing, duly authenticated by the Registrar or any other officer authorized by the Commission, for this purpose.

➤ **Limitation Period-**

The Commission shall not admit any complaint on the non-compliance of the order of the Commission by the Public Authority, unless it is filed by the appellant within a period of one year from the date of such order issued by the Commission.

CHAPTER – 6

6.1.National Federation of Information Commission in India (NFICI)

The National Federation of Information Commission in India was formed as a registered body on 01.09.2009, with an objective of facilitating co-ordination and mutual consultation among the Central Information Commission and the State Information Commissions constituted under the Right to Information Act, 2005. The Membership is open to all Information Commissions in India and they have to pay Rs.5.00 lakhs towards Admission Fee and an Annual Membership fee of Rs.1.00 lakh. The Tamil Nadu Information Commission has enrolled as a member to the National Federation of Information Commissions in India, during the year 2011. The Tamil Nadu Information Commission has paid the Annual Membership fee of Rs.1.00 lakh to the National Federation of Information Commission in India for 2023-2024.

CHAPTER – 7

7.1.Meeting on the Speedy Disposal of RTI Petitions

Meetings were held with the representatives of Public Authorities namely, officials from the Departments of Secretariat, Heads of Departments and Personal Assistants (General) of all Districts under the Chairmanship of State Chief Information Commissioner along with the other Six State Information Commissioners on 22.08.2023. During the meeting, the State Chief Information Commissioner instructed the representatives of Public Authorities to dispose the petitions received under the Right to Information Act, 2005, within the time frame, as prescribed in the Act. In order to maintain transparency in the administration, the State Chief Information Commissioner has suggested the Public Authorities to take prompt action to upload the necessary information required under the Section 4(1)(b) of the Act, in their respective Departmental websites as well as in the Public Domain.



Chapter – 8

8.1.RTI Week Celebrations in Tamil Nadu Information Commission

RTI Week is celebrated during 5th - 12th October of every year to create awareness among the Citizens as well as Public Authorities about the provisions of the Right to Information Act, 2005. The information seekers use the Right to Information Act, 2005 not just to access the information but also as a gateway for their grievances. In order to promote the objective of the Right to Information Act, 2005, and also to create general awareness among the public through celebration of RTI week, Tamil Nadu Information Commission has requested the Public Authorities, District Collectors of all the Districts as well as educational institutions to conduct various events namely training to Public Information Officers in handling RTI petitions, Seminars, Competitions, quiz programmes, Marathon and Walkathon among the College and School students, during the RTI week.

To celebrate RTI Week in the Tamil Nadu Information Commission, State Chief Information Commissioner and State Information Commissioners interacted with the former State Chief Information Commissioners and State Information Commissioners on 12.10.2023. During the interaction, the former State Chief Information Commissioners and State Information Commissioners have shared their valuable and fruitful experiences with the State Chief Information Commissioner and State Information Commissioners.

CHAPTER –9

9.1.Implementation of Hybrid Mode of Hearing / Hearing through Video Conferencing in Tamil Nadu Information Commission

Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its order dt: 09.10.2023 in W.P.(C) No.360/2021, filed by Sri Kishan Chand Jain, has directed that all State Information Commissions shall implement hybrid mode of hearings and e-filing of appeals before 31.12.2023. In G.O.(Ms) No.116, Human Resources Management (AR-III) Department, dt. 31.12.2023, the Government of Tamil Nadu have accorded administrative sanction for implementation of Hybrid Mode of Hearing and e-filing of Appeals in Tamil Nadu Information Commission.

Chapter – 10

10.1.Preparation of Annual Report, 2023

As per Section 25(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005, the Commission is required to prepare a report after the end of each year, on the implementation of the provisions of this Act during that year and a copy thereof is to be forwarded to the appropriate Government, which in turn will lay it before the State Legislature.

As per Section 25(2) of the Right to Information Act, 2005, each Ministry or Department shall, in relation to the public authorities within their jurisdiction collect and provide information to the State Information Commission, as is required to prepare the report. The Annual Report, 2023, has been prepared based on the particulars received from the Public Authorities on the implementation of Right to Information Act during the year 2023.

10.2.Right to Information Petitions handled by the Public Authorities during 2023

The particulars on number of requests made to each Public Authority and amount of charges collected, disposal of Right to Information applications by the Public Information Officers and disposal of first appeals by the Appellate Authorities during the year 2023, number of requests rejected under various provisions of the Right to Information Act, are shown in the Annexure of this report. 







Details of Second Appeals Disposed during the last Five Years are shown in the Chart -V.





CHAPTER – 13

13.1.Recommendations of the Commission

Tamil Nadu Information Commission suggests the following recommendations to the Government under Section 25(5) of the Right to Information Act, 2005, for the effective functioning of the Commission.

1. Many RTI petitioners and Appellants have filed multiple RTI applications on the same subject and also seek the same information which increases the work load and burden of the various public authorities as well as the State Information Commission. In this connection, the Government has to take measures to check the duplication of application by increasing the RTI fees amount, so as to redress the grievances of the genuine citizens through RTI by the public authorities and State Information Commission efficiently and effectively.

2. State Information Commission should be provided with sufficient funds for creating necessary infrastructure facilities for online inquiries, implementation of e-office and outsourcing the personnel, which will strengthen the Commission to dispose the Second Appeal petitions in the speedy manner.

3. The Government have to issue necessary instructions to the public authorities to upload their important Government Orders, Government letters, Memorandums and Instructions in their respective portals/Websites, which would enable the Public to download the requisite information through Government websites, indirectly reducing the RTI applications.

4. In order to create awareness on RTI, it is recommended that a chapter on the importance of Right to Information Act, 2005, shall be added in the School / College curriculum. The Government may allot sufficient fund for the celebrations of RTI Week during October 5th – 12th of every year, so as to create the awareness about the importance of RTI Act among the Public Authorities as well as among the Public.
